

VERIFICATION STATEMENT CARBON FOOTPRINT OF PRODUCT 0710

INTRODUCTION AND OBJECTIVE OF THE STUDY

Bureau Veritas Polska Sp. z o.o. (Bureau Veritas) was engaged by Vinci Play Sp. z o.o. (Vinci Play) to verify the greenhouse gas emissions of 11 product groups. This Verification Statement relates to the information covered by the scope of work described below.

The scope of verification included input data regarding the raw materials used for emission calculations. This data was derived from Vinci Play's internal records. As the emission calculators were developed by Bureau Veritas and the emission factors contained therein were also selected by Bureau Veritas, these elements were not subject to a separate verification process.

BASIC INFORMATION

Greenhouse gas emission boundaries: Cradle-to-gate

Period covered by the greenhouse gas emissions verification: The year 2025 (01.01.2025 – 31.12.2025)

Verification criteria: WRI/WBCSD, Greenhouse Gas Protocol. The Product Life Cycle Accounting and Reporting Standard

Standard used to conduct the verification: ISO 14064-3: Greenhouse gases - Part 3: Specification with guidance for the verification and validation of greenhouse gas statements

Assurance level: Limited

Functional unit: One complete device
